

Greyhound Racing Victoria Trialling Policy During Race Meetings

Reviewed July 2015

This policy refers to greyhounds trialling during metropolitan and country race meetings. The following guidelines shall apply when consideration is given for trialling.

- Trials will be conducted under LRR 39.1 & 39.2
- Greyhound must be domiciled outside the state of Victoria and trialling in preparation for a group event at that track.
- Trial is conducted within the fourteen days prior to the commencement of that event.
- Sufficient kennel space is available.
- All trials must be approved by the Chief Steward.
- The Chief Steward, at his absolute discretion, may grant special permission for trials to be conducted, when the promotion of Greyhound Racing is involved.

Please Note – Greyhounds that have been drawn as reserves at metropolitan meeting, but have not gained a start will no longer be permitted to trial.

For the purpose of this policy domiciled outside that state of Victoria will be defined as 120 days out of the last 150 days prior to the event.
